Commencing at the 1/4 sec. Corner bet. secs. 20 & 21 in Township 6 North Range 32 East W. M. I, set fir post 4 feet long 4 ins. Sq 18 ins. in the Ground 20 feet West of Initial point marked P. No 544, Dug pits North and South of post and built mound of earth 18 inches deep 4 feet wide at base, Thence I run 8000 chains to the 1/4 Sec. corner bet. secs. 28 & 29 set post 4 feet long 4 inches sq, 20 feet West of Corner marked I. M. dug pits North and South of Post and built mound of earth 18 inches high 4 feet wide at base. Thence I run:
