the Diminished Umatilla Indian Reservation, follows
said road, thence, as near as practicable, along
the Umatilla river, in a North Easterly direc-
tion to its intersection with the line between
ranges 36 and 37 East of the Willamette
Meridian in Umatilla Co, Oregon.

Now on this day comes
the Report of H. M. Ritner, Lot Rivermore and John
S. Vinson the viewers heretofore appointed at the McR
Term 1894 of this court, to view out and report upon
the location of the above mentioned road, for final
hearing the same having been read on a previous day
of this term of this court, to wit, May Term 1894 and
the said viewers having reported favorable and rec-
ommending the establishing of the same as a
County Road and the field notes and plat of
Survey of said Road, being duly on file and certified
to by the Surveyor appointed to survey the same, and
there being no remonstrance against said road.

It is therefore ordered by the court that the report of
said viewers be accepted and that said Road be established
in accordance with said Report, and that the Report
of said viewers, field notes and plat of Survey thereof be
recorded as by law required, and that the road be supervised

through whose District said proposed road passes be directed to open the same for the Public use as a County Road.
