Now on this day this matter coming on now to be heard upon the report of the Board of County Road viewers heretofore instructed to view and report upon said proposed road and said report having been publicly read on two different days of the same term of Court to-wit:- Having been publicly read the first time on July 3rd, 1929, and publicly read the second time on July 5th, 1929, and is now up for final hearing and it duly appearing that no objections or exceptions are on file against said road or report and said board of viewers finds that said road as located, surveyed and laid out to be a feasible and necessary one and a benefit to the public, therefore, it respectfully recommend that it be opened and established as a County Road of Umatilla County, Oregon.

The Board of County Road Viewers further recommend that this road be located so as to follow in general the present traveled road, now washed out, except that it be kept at all times on the west side of the draw or canyon and raised up on the side hill far enough to be removed from the danger of washouts when the creek is flooding.

IT IS THEREFORE, HEREBY ORDERED that said report of the Board of County Road Viewers be adopted in full and that said road be established and declared a public Highway of Umatilla County, Oregon and the said ^{road} be finally surveyed and opened for public use.
