IN THE COUNTY COURT OF THE STATE OF OREGON FOR UMATILLA COUNTY.

In the matter of opening County Road
No. 636, petitioned for by W H Bell,
et al.

Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard upon the report of the Board of County Road Viewers heretofore instructed at the January 1908 term of this Court to view, survey, stake and lay out Road No. 636, as follows: Commencing at a point in the center of county road No. 578 of Umatilla County where said road crosses the East line of the SW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 17, Township 1 North Range 34 EWM. at which point is placed a large stone the same being about 12 ft North of the SE corner said SW 1/4 NE 1/4 said Section 17; thence running Northwesterly and along the most practicable route for a road a distance of 200 ft. to a mound of stone with a stake standing in the center thereof; thence running North Easterly and along the most practicable route for a road a distance of 300 ft. to a point of said East line of said SW 1/4 NE 1/4 said Section 17, which point is marked with a pile of stones with a stake in the center thereof; thence running North to the center of said NE 1/4 said Section 17; thence West to NW Cor. of said SW 1/4 of said NE 1/4 said Section 17, where it again intersects said County Road No. 578 for final hearing, the same having been publicly read on two different days of the same term of court, to-wit: Having been publicly read 1st time on February 6, 1908 and publicly read the 2nd time on February 8, 1908, and the board of County Road viewers having reported favorably and recommended the establishing of said road as a county road, and said plat and field notes being on file, and certified to by the surveyor appointed to survey the same and the Court being satisfied that said road would be of sufficient public utility, it is hereby ORDERED that said report be accepted and that said road be opened as a county road and that the plat and field notes be recorded in the Record of Plats and Field Notes of Umatilla County, and that the road supervisor through whose

district said road runs be and he is hereby ordered and instructed to open said County Road for public use. As soon as the damages to be sustained to the property owners by reason of the location of said road are paid by the petitioners; said damages as are assessed by the Board of County Road Viewers are as follows: The owner of the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 17, Tp. 1 N. R. 34 EWM. in the sum of \$25.00.
