IN THE COUNTY COURT OF THE STATE OF OREGON FOR UMATILLA COUNTY?

In the matter of opening county road
No. 640.

Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard upon the report of the board of county road-viewers heretofore instructed at the January 1908 term of this Court to view, survey, stake lay out and report upon said road no 640, as follows: Commencing at a point on the line of the Umatilla Indian Reservation 80 rods South from the NW corner Sec. 6, Tp. 1 S R 34 EWM. thence easterly and north easterly across the Oberg premises so called about 80 rods to a point on the base line between secs 6 Tp. 1 S. R. 34 EWM. and Sec. 31, Tp. 1 N. R. 34 EWM. on present traveled road; thence along said present traveled road Northeasterly on the South bank of the North fork of Mc Kay creek to a point near the dwelling house on the S. L. Morse place, so-called thence still in the same direction over a point of land and thence again along said South bank of said creek along the present traveled road in a North easterly direction about 2-1/2 miles to that point thereon which is nearest to the center of section 28, Tp. 1 N. R. 34 EWM and to be 40 ft wide as a county road for final hearing, the same having been publicly read ~~the existing~~ on two different days of the same term of court, to-wit: Having been publicly read the 1st time on Feb. 6, 1908 and publicly read the 2nd time on Feb. 8, 1908 and the Board of county road viewers having reported favorably and recommended the establishment of said road as a county road, and the plat and field notes being on file and certified to by the surveyor appointed to survey the same, and it appearing to the court that said road would be of sufficient public utility, it is hereby ordered that said report be accepted and the plat and field notes be recorded in the Record of plats and field notes for Umatilla County and that the road supervisor through whose district or districts said road runs be and he is hereby ordered and instructed to open said road for public use, when the damages are paid to Carl Oberg by the petitioners in the sum of \$50.00.

In the matter of opening County Road No. 640.

Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard upon the report of the Board of County Road Viewers heretofore instructed at the January 1908 term of this Court to view, survey, stake and lay out and report upon said Road No 640, as follows: Commencing at a point on the line of the Umatilla Indian Reservation 80 rods South from the NW corner Sec. 6, Tp. 1 S R 34 EWM; thence Easterly and North Easterly across the Oberg premises so called about 80 rods to a point on the base line between Secs 6 Tp 1 S. R. 34 EWM., and Sec 21, T. 1 N. R. 34 EWM, on present traveled road; thence along said present traveled road Northeastly on the South Bank of the North fork of Mc Kay creek to a point near the dwelling house on the S. L. Morse place, so-called thence still in the same direction over a point or line and thence again along said South part of said creek along the present traveled road in a North Easterly direction about 2 1/2 miles to that point thereon which is nearest to the center of Section 28, Tp. 1 N. R. 34 EWM and to be 40ft wide as a county road for final hearing.

The same having been publicly read on two different days of the same term of Court, to-wit: Having been publicly read the 1st time on Feb. 5, 1908 and publicly read the 2nd time on Feb. 8, 1908 and the Board of County Road Viewers having reported favorably and recommended the establishment of said road as a county road and the plat and field notes being on file and certified to by the surveyor appointed to survey the same, and it appearing to the court that said road would be of sufficient public utility, it is hereby ORDERED that said report be accepted and that the plat and field notes be recorded in the Record or Plats and Field Notes for Umatilla County and that the Road Supervisor through whose District or Districts said road runs be and he is hereby ordered and instructed to open said road for public use. When the damages are paid to Carl Oberg by the petitioners in the sum of \$50.00.
