

IN THE COUNTY COURT OF THE STATE OF OREGON FOR UMATILLA COUNTY.

Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard upon the report of the board of county road viewers heretofore instructed at the January 1908 term of this Court to view, survey, stake, lay out and report upon said road No. 639 as follows: Commencing at a point on the section line between sections 1 and 12 township 1 south range 33 ewm 13 chains West of the NE corner said Section 12; thence running in a southerly or South Easterly direction up Mc Kay creek on the most feasible and practicable route for a public road and as nearly as practicable along the present traveled road through the NE corner of said Section 12 and across the SW corner of Section 7, and through sections 18 and 19 in TP/ 1 S. R. 34 EWM. and crossing the NE cor. of Sec. 30, said Tp and Range to a point on the line between Secs. 29 and 30 said Tp. and range 53 1/3 rods South of the NW corner said Sec. 29, thence in an Easterly direction up said Mc Kay creek on the most practicable and feasible route for a road to a point on the line between sections 22 and 27 Township 1 South Range 34 EWM. 17 chains East of the 1/4 section corner common to said Secs. 22 and 27, and to be 40 ft wide as a county road for final hearing, the same having been publicly read on two different days of the same term of court, to-wit: Having been publicly read the 1st time on Feb. 6, 1908 and public<sup>ly</sup> read the 2nd time on Feb. 8, 1908. Said Board of County Road Viewers having reported favorably and recommended the establishing of said road as a county road, and the plat and field notes being on file and certified to by the surveyor appointed to survey the same, and it appearing to the court that said road would be of sufficient public utility, it is hereby ordered that said report of the board of county road viewers be accepted and the plats and Field notes be recorded in the Record of Plats and Field Notes of Umatilla County

and the Road Supervisor through whose district or districts said road runs be and he is hereby ordered and instructed to open said road for public use.
