Now on this day this matter coming on to be heard upon the report of the board of county road viewers heretofore instructed at the August, 1922 term of this court to view, survey if necessary, and report upon said proposed road petitioned by as commencing at a point on the South side of the Old Oregon Trail Highway where the North and South Section line between section 9 and 10, Township 2 North Range 33, E.W.M., crosses said Highway and running thence South 6 3/4 miles more or less, to the corner of Section 9, 10, 15 and 16, Township 1 North, Range 33 E.W.M., thence west one mile to the corner of Sections 8, 9, 16 and 17 of the same township and range, thence West 2 5/8 miles along the section line to the top of the hill on the North and South line between Sections 28 and 29, thence following the line of the proposed road as it is platted and approved by the U. S. Government, across sections 28 and 29 and 33 of Township 1 North, Range 33 E.W.M., thence across Section 5, Township 1 South Range 33 E.W.M., to the east bank of McKay Creek, thence following up McKay Creek along the most practicable and feasible route for a road through Sections 4, 3, 2, and 1, to the corner of Section 1 and 12, in Township 1 South, Range 33 E.W.M., on the township line between townships 33 and 34, E.W.M., and to be 60 feet wide for a county road for final hearing, the same having been publicly read on two different days of the same term of the Court, to-wit: Having been publicly read the first time on September 6 and publicly read the second time on September 7, 1922; said board of County Road viewers having reported favorably and recommended that said road be established as a county road, and that the damage sustained to the property owners by reason of establishment of said road will be

nothing.

And that the Court being of the opinion that said road will be of sufficient utility,

IT IS THEREFORE HEREBY ORDERED that said report of the board of County Road viewers be approved and that the plat be recorded in the record of proceedings of Umatilla County, and that the Roadmaster be and he is hereby ordered and instructed to open said road for public use.
