County Road No 382 described as follows To wit:

Beginning at the North East corner of the South East quarter
of Section 35 Tp 1 NR 32 E. W. M Thence following the Section
line North to the NE corner of Section 14 in said Tp & R, Thence
along the most practicable route to the south east corner ^{NE 1/4}
of Section Eleven (11) in said Township, Thence due North to
Dry Luta Willow Creek, Thence by the nearest and most
practicable route to intersect the County road leading
from Dundleton to Long Creek at a point near said Dry
Luta Willow Creek where has been planted a stake marked R
all in Multnomah County Oregon

To the Honorable County Court of the State of Oregon for Multnomah
County.

We the undersigned, the viewers heretofore appointed to view and
locate Road No 382 submit the following report: Pursuant to an
order of the Honorable Court we met Jno C Arnold, County
Surveyor at Dundleton on 16th day of Feb 1892 and were
by him, each duly sworn to faithfully and impartially dis-
charge the duties of our appointments

come a public highway

All stakes or posts are of legal size and are marked and set in mounds as by law required.

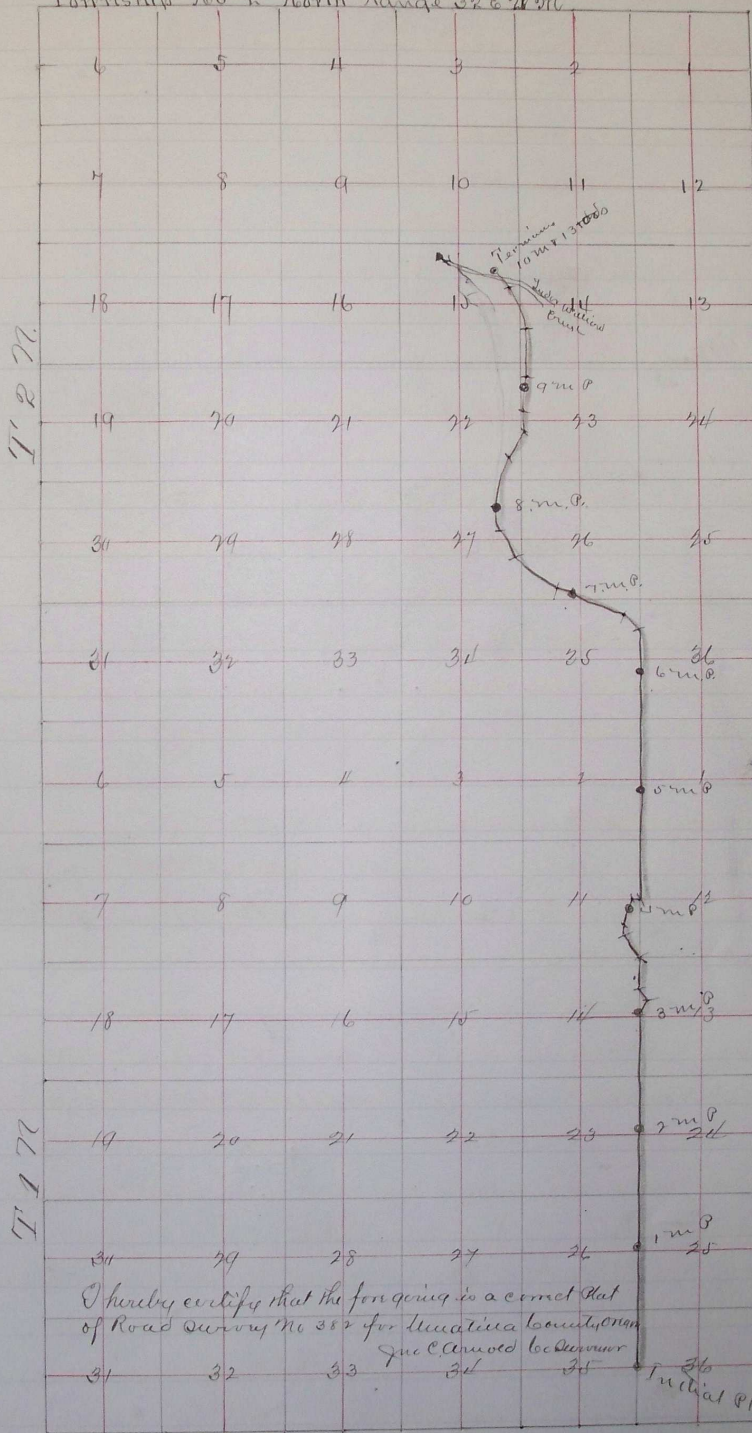
