RESOLUTION.

It at this time appearing to the county court of Umatilla County State of Oregon, that for the convenience of and interest of the residents living near Stanfield, Oregon.

That a public Highway established as herein after described and the court aforesaid being fully satisfied that the establishment of such road and the opening ~~of~~ thereof are of great public necessity,

THEFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that it is the intention of the County Court of Umatilla County, State of Oregon proceeding under and by virtue of Chapter 295, General Laws of Oregon for 1917, to locate and establish a County Road in Road District No 31 County and State aforesaid, said road to be know as the Dunning Road, commencing, running and terminating as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the 1/4 Sec. Corner between Sec. 26-27 of Tp. 4 N R 29 E., thence North along the Section line between Sections 26-27-1332 ft to the 1/16 corner; thence due East 5316 ft to the North 1/16 corner between Sec. 25-26, Tp. 4 N R 29 E W M.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the above entitled matter be heard at the regular January term, for the year 1921 of said County Court, at the County Court room in the courthouse in Pendleton, Oregon.

And it is hereby further Ordered that true copies of this Resolution properly certified to as such by the County Clerk, be posted by the county surveyor as follows, to-wit:

That a copy be posted on the bulletin board at the north entrance of the Court house, in the city of Pendleton, Umatilla county state of Oregon, the same be^{ing} the ~~same~~ place where the county court is held that three copies be posted in a public place and

in plain ~~view~~ of the public and, ⁱⁿ the vicinity of said proposed county road.

And that this resolution be duly entered in the commissioner's Journal.
