

IN THE COUNTY COURT OF THE STATE OF OREGON FOR UMATILLA COUNTY.

In the Matter of the County Road
beginning at $\frac{1}{4}$ section, between sections
26 and 27 township 4 north range 29 E W M
and known as the Dunning Road.

Now on this day this matter coming to be heard in open court the report of the county road viewers in the above entitled matter said report having been publicly read the second time before this court on February, 3rd, 1921, and the court having thereupon at this time duly proceeded to consider said report of said board of county road viewers and the said board of county road viewers having determined that the premises through which the above proposed road is located would be rendered less valuable in the premises, in the sum of nothing, and there being no objections or remonstrances filed upon said matter and the court being now fully advised relative thereto and appearing to the satisfaction of the court that there are sufficient reasons, why said road should be established, and no Petition for damages whatsoever having been presented or filed in said matter.

And the court at this time having duly considered said report of said county road viewers and the recommendation attached to said report, and the county board viewers having in their said report recommended that said proposed road be established as a regular county road and the court being fully satisfied that said road will be of great public utility and the immediate opening of said road is of great public necessity, and the court being fully advised.

THEREUPON AND THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED UNANSWERED AND ADJUDGED that said report of said Board of County road Viewers be and the same is hereby adopted in full; that the recommendation contained in said report be and the same are hereby adopted; that said proposed road as described in the Resolution herein, and as shown in the said recommendation attached thereto be made a part of said Board of County Road viewers report be and the same is hereby established as a County Road and Public Highway, that the same be opened _____ feet in width.
