In the Matter of opening County  
 Road No. 758 petitioned for by  
 James E. Faucett, et al.

Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard upon the report of the Board of County Road Viewers heretofore instructed at the October 1913 term of this court to view, survey and report upon said proposed road No. 758 petitioned for as commencing at a point 20 feet south of the point where the South line of the right of way for the Government Feed Canal intersects the east line of Sec. 5 Tp. 3 N. R. 29 Thence Northeasterly parallel with the south line of said Government Feed Canal right of way and at a distance of 20 feet therefrom to a point 20 feet east of the point where the southerly line of the right of way for the Government Feed Canal intersects the North Line of the Southwest quarter of Sec. 4 Tp. 3 N.R. 29 E.W.M. as a County Road for final hearing, the same having been publicly read on two different days of the same term of Court, to-wit: Having been publicly read the first time on November 5th, 1913, and publicly read the second time on November 5th, 1913 and the said Board of County Road Viewers having reported favorably and recommended that said road be established and declared a public highway of Umatilla County, Oregon, and the plat and field notes being on file and certified to by the Surveyor who surveyed the same, and the Court being satisfied that said road would be of sufficient utility it is hereby ordered that said report be approved and that the same be recorded in the records of plats and field notes of Umatilla County, and that the Road Supervisor through whose district said road runs be and is hereby ordered to open said road for public use.

In the Matter of County  
 Road No. 759.

Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard upon the report of the Board of County Road Viewers heretofore instructed at the October term of this Court to view, survey and report upon said proposed road No. 759, and the Court not being now fully advised in the matter,

It is hereby ordered that further consideration in this matter be and the same is hereby continued until the next regular term of this Court.

In the Matter of Change in  
 Road No. 683 petitioned for by  
 James E. Faucett, et al.

Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard upon the report of the Board of County Road Viewers heretofore instructed at the October, 1913 term of this Court, to view, survey, and report upon the proposed changing and alteration of County Road No. 683, and the Court not being at this time fully advised as to the practicability of said proposed alterations, it is hereby ordered that further consideration of this matter continued until the next regular term of this court.

In the Matter of vacating a  
 portion of County Road No. 298

Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard upon the report of the Board of County Road Viewers heretofore instructed at the October 1913 term of this Court to view, survey and report upon the vacating of said road commencing at a point where the southerly boundary of the right of way of the U.S. Reclamation service feed Canal intersects the North line of the southwest quarter of section four Township 3 North, Range 29 E.W.M. run thence west to the east line of section 5 of said township and Range for the vacating of said road for final hearing, the same having been publicly read on two different days of the same term of court to-wit: having been publicly read the first time on November 5th, 1913 and publicly read the second time on November 6th, 1913, and the said Board of County Road Viewers having reported favorably and recommended that said road be vacated and the plat and field notes being on file and certified to by the Surveyor who surveyed the same, and the Court being now satisfied that said road is not of sufficient public utility,

It is therefore hereby ordered that said report be approved and that said road be vacated as prayed for and that the road supervisor through whose district said road is now established is hereby ordered and instructed to close said road to the public.
