

To the Honorable County Court of the State of Oregon, for Umatilla County.

WE THE UNDERSIGNED, your petitioners, who are freeholders of said Umatilla County, Oregon, and who reside in the road district, or districts where said road is to be laid out, respectfully petition your honorable body to cause to be laid out, located, and established a County Road in said County and State, commencing, running and terminating as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at a point in the county road ten chains North Easterly from where the said county road crosses the Furnish Ditch in the S. E. 1/4 of the S. W. 1/4 of Section 9, Township No 3 N. R. 29 East W. M., Thence by the most practical route to the center of the said section 9; Thence North <sup>two miles</sup> through the center of the North half of the said section 9, and continuing North through the center of section 4, (in said Township 3 N. R. 29 E. W. M.) and the South half of section 33, Township 4 N. R. 29 E. W. M., and terminating at the county road at the center of the said section 33, Twp. 4 N. R. 29 East W. M. ---

Said road to be Forty (40.) feet wide.

And your petitioners will ever pray.
