Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard upon the report of the Board of County Road Viewers, heretofore instructed at the April 1914 term of this Court to view, survey and report upon said proposed road No 765, petitioned for, as Commencing at the Southeast corner  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Northeast of Section 5 Tp 4 N Range 28 E W M, and running thence due east to the North bank of the Umatilla river; thence along said bank of the Umatilla river to a point of rocks on the quarter section line about 500 feet north of the Southeast corner of the Northwest Quarter of Section 4 Tp 4 N R 28 E W M, and to be 40 feet wide, as a county road, for final hearing the same having been publicly read on two different days of the same term of court, to-wit: having been publicly read the first time on May 6th 1914, and publicly read the second time on May 7th 1914, and the said Board of County Road Viewers, by J W Kimbrell and W J Stockman, being two of its members, having reported favorably and recommended that said road declared and established as a public highway of Umatilla County, and the plat and field notes being on file and certified to by the Surveyor who surveyed the same and there being no objection on file against said report or against the petition filed herein, and the court being satisfied that said road would be of sufficient public utility, it is, **HEREBY ORDERED**, that said report of the Board of County Road Viewers, be approved, and that said report and plat be recorded in the record of plats and field notes of Umatilla County, and that the Road Supervisor through whose district said road runs, be and is  $\frac{1}{2}$  hereby ordered to open said road for public use.
