Petitioned for by Henry M Somerer et al.

Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard upon the report of the board of County Road viewers heretofore instructed at the September 1912 term of this Court to view, survey, stake and lay out said proposed road No. 742 petitioned for as follows: Commencing at the northwest corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 22, Tp 5 N R 29 E W M thence in a Northeasterly direction over the most practicable route through sections 22, 23, 14, 11 and 12 crossing the O W R & N right of way at a crossing in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 11, thence in a northeasterly direction to a post set in the ground situated about the center of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 12, Tp 5 N R 29 E W M at place known as Simmons Landing and there terminating and to be 60 feet wide as the county road for final hearing the same having been publicly read on two different days of the same term of court to-wit: having been publicly read the first time on Dec 4, 1912 and publicly read the second time on Dec 5, 1912 and the same board of county road viewers having reported favorably and recommended that said road be established and declared a public highway of Umatilla County and the plat and field notes being on file and certified to by the surveyor appointed to survey the same and the court being satisfied that said road would be of sufficient public utility and there being no remonstrance or objection on file against said report, it is hereby ordered by the court that said report of the Board of County road viewers be approved and that the same be recorded in the records of Plats and field notes of Umatilla County and that the road supervisor through whose district said road runs be and he is hereby ordered and instructed to open for public use.

Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard upon the report of the board of county road viewers heretofore instructed at the September term of this court to view, survey, stake, and lay out said proposed road No. 743 petitioned for as follows: Commencing at the Southwest corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 28 Tp 5 N R 29 E W M running thence North 1 mile terminating at the Northwest corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 28 Tp 5 N R 29 E W M and to be 40 feet wide as the county road for final hearing, the same having been publicly read the first time on Dec 4, 1912 and publicly read the second time on Dec 5, 1912. And the same board of County road viewers having reported favorably and recommended that said road to be established and declared a public highway of Umatilla County and the plat and field notes being on file and certified to by the surveyor appointed to survey the same and the court being satisfied that said road would be of sufficient public utility and there being no remonstrance or objection on file against said report, it is hereby ordered by the court that said report of the board of county road viewers be approved and that the same be recorded in the records of Plats and field notes of Umatilla County and that the road supervisor through whose district said road runs be and he is hereby ordered and instructed to open said road for public use.

Whereupon the hour of adjournment having arrived the Court adjourned for the term.
