 0      OPENING ROAD NO 699.

Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard to be heard upon the report of the Board of County Road Viewers, heretofore instructed at the February 1911 term of this Court, to view, survey and report on said proposed road No 699, petitioned for as follows: commencing at the southeast corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of section 32 Tp 5 N.R. 29 E.W.M running thence north through the center of said Section 32, one mile to the Northeast corner of of NW $\frac{1}{4}$  and to 40 feet wide, as a county road, for final hearing, and the said board of county road viewers having reported favorably and recommended that said road be declared and established as a county road, and there being no remonstrance on file against said report or petition filed herein, and the court being satisfied that said road would be of sufficient public utility, it is, THEREFORE HEREBY ORDERED, that said report of the board of county road viewers, be approved, and that the plat and field notes be recorded in the record of plats and field notes of Umatilla County, and that the road supervisor through whose district said road runs, be and is hereby ordered to open said road for public use, and that the petitioners haul the pipes or other materials necessary for for the ditch crossings from the station and place the same in position at their own expense.
