

REPORT OF BOARD OF COUNTY ROAD VIEWERS

IN THE MATTER OF VIEWING, SURVEYING AND LAYING OUT
COUNTY ROAD NO. 706

TO THE HONORABLE COUNTY COURT OF THE STATE OF OREGON, FOR UMATILLA COUNTY.

WE, THE UNDERSIGNED Board of County Road Viewers, heretofore instructed to view, survey, and locate Road No. 706, submit the following report:

Pursuant to an order of the Honorable County Court, we met at the commencement point of said road, on the 20th day of May, 1911.

We called to our aid

who were by the Surveyor each duly sworn. We viewed, surveyed, and located said Road No. 706, as specified in our order. We find said route practicable as follows: Beginning at the present county road, a point North 847 ft. from the S. W. corner of the N. W. 1/4 of the N. W. 1/4 of Sec. 3, T. 4 N., R. 28 E., W. M. and ending at the ending point of said road; the remaining portion of said road as petitioned for being covered by present county road and by Road No. 707 reported upon at this time.

We would most respectfully recommend that the said road be declared and established a public highway provided the present traveled County road be vacated where it goes through the N. E. corner of Sec. 4 T. 4 N., R. 28 E., W. M.

If the proposed new road were established in lieu of said portion of old road there would be no damage sustained by property owners along the route. The proposed new road would accommodate the traffic as well as the said portion of the old road and would not cut up private property as much as the said portion of the old road.

The cost of construction will be nothing.
