

IN THE COUNTY COURT OF THE STATE OF OREGON FOR THE COUNTY OF

In the matter of locating, establishing :  
altering, widening, straightening and  
changing of a county road from the county:  
line between the counties of Morrow and  
Umatilla, Oregon, easterly thru the towns:  
of Umatilla, Hermiston, Stanfield, and :  
Echo to a point in the center of county  
road no. 799 in the County of Umatilla  
State of Oregon, same being known as the :  
Morrow County Line, Echo Section of the  
Columbia River Highway. :

Now on this day this matter coming on to be heard upon the report of the Board of County Road Viewers, heretofore instructed to view and report upon said propose road, and said report having been publicly read on two different days of the same term of Court, to-wit: having been publicly read the first time of Dec. 1st. 1926 and publicly read for the second time on Dec. 2nd, 1926, and is now up for final hearing, and it duly appearing that no objection or exceptions are on file against said road or report, and said board of viewers, finds that said road as laid out would be a practicable and necessary one and a benefit to the general public, and recommended that said road be declared and established as a County road of Umatilla County, Oregon, and the said Board finds that the owners of the land through which said road is to be laid out and established. will be damaged and the land rendered less valuable by reason of the establishing of said road as follows:

Section 24, T. 4 N.R. 28 E.W.M.- \$ 34.50 and the moving of the fences  
back to the right of way line.

The Northwest Quarter, Section 9,  
T. 3 N.R. 29 E.W.M.- \$ 25.00 and the moving of the  
fences back to the right of way  
line.

The Southwest Quarter, Section 9,  
T. 3 N.R. 29 E.W.M.- \$ 20.00 and the moving of the  
fences back to the right of way  
line

The Northeast Quarter of the  
Northeast Quarter, Section 21, T.  
3 N.R. 29 E.W.M. North and East  
of the Columbia River Highway \$ 50.00 and the moving of the  
fences back to the right of way  
line.

The above listed damages are for the additional strip necessary to  
make a sixty foot right of way.

All other lands are made less valuable in the sum of nothing.

IT IS THEREFORE HEREBY ORDERED that said report of the Board of  
County Road Viewers. be approved. that said road be established and declared a  
public highway of Umatilla County, and that the Clerk of this Court be instructe  
to draw warrant to pay the necessary expenses of viewing said road and to draw  
warrant to pay such damages as are herewith awarded.
