TO THE HONORABLE COUNTY COURT OF THE STATE OF OREGON FOR UMATILLA COUNTY:

We, the undersigned Board of County Road Viewers, heretofore instructed to view the above mentioned road, submit the following report;

Pursuant to your order we met at the beginning point of said road on the 14th day of October, 1926, and having qualified as viewers, proceeded to view the said road.

We find the road as laid out to be a practicable and a necessary one and a benefit to the public, therefore we respectfully recommend that it be established as a County Road of Umatilla County, Oregon.

We find that the lands through which the said road is laid out will be made less valuable in the following amounts, by reason of its establishment;

Section 24, T. 4 N. R. 28 E.W.M.-	\$ 34.50 and the moving of the fences back to the right of way line.
The Northwest Quarter, Section 9, T. 3 N. R. 29 E. W.M.-	\$ 25.00 and the moving of the fences back to the right of way line.
The Southwest Quarter, Section 9, T. 3 N. R. 29 E. W.M.-	\$ 20.00 and the moving of the fences back to the right of way line
The Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter, Section 21, T. 3 N. R. 29 E. W.M. North and East of the Columbia River Highway	\$ 50.00 and the moving of the fences back to the right of way line

The above listed damages are for the additional strip necessary to make a sixty foot right of way.

All other lands are made less valuable in the sum of nothing.
