In the Matter of Deed to John H. Brinker and Andy B. Johnson

Now on this day this matter coming on to be considered, and the court finds that John H. Brinker and Andy B. Johnson have tendered into Court the sum of One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) for back taxes upon Lots three (3) and four (4) in block two (2) in Stout's Addition to Milton, said property having heretofore been sold to Umatilla County at a delinquent tax sale, and the Court having duly considered the matter it is hereby ordered that the Clerk of this court do issue a quit claim deed, conveying said property to John H. Brinker and Andy B. Johnson

In the Matter of Deeds for Roadways signed by W. L. Kellum and Wife, and F. A. Michael, and wife, and J. M. Harrison, a widower.

Now on this day this matter coming on to be considered, upon the deeds from W.L. Kellum, et ux, F. A. Michael, et ux, and J.M.Harrison, a widower, conveying certain lands in Sec.13, 2N 31 EWM to be used as a County Road, and known as "Birch Creek" Road, and the Court being satisfied that said deeds are a good and sufficient deed of conveyance of the land therein described, it is hereby ordered that said deeds be accepted as and for a County Road of Umatilla County, and said deeds be recorded in the office of County Recorder of Umatilla County.
