Notice is hereby given that a petition will be presented to the County Court of the State of Oregon, for Umatilla County, by the undersigned, who are residents and householders of said County and State and reside in the vicinity of the hereinafter described route for a County road, at the May term, 1898, of said County Court, to-wit: On the Fourth day of May, 1898, praying said Court to lay out, locate and establish a County road in said County and State, commencing,

running and terminating as follows, to-wit: Commencing at a point 80 rods south of the NE corner Sec 7 in T2N R32E W1M thence in a westerly direction following the old traveled road from James Danill's Place to Bonhart Station as near as most practicable for an easy grade, through Sec 7 in T2N R32E W1M and secs 12 & 13 in T2N R31E W1M to a point - 17 rods North of the SW corner Sec 12 in T2N R31E W1M

Said road to be 40 feet wide.
