Court met on this day pursuant to adjournment, present the same officers as on the last day and the Journal of the last day's proceedings was read and is hereby approved and signed; and, among other proceedings, the following were had, to-wit:

In the Matter of County Road, No. 775,
Petitioned for by J. T. Hinkle, et al.

Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard upon the report of the Board of County Road Viewers heretofore instructed by the Court to view, survey, stake and lay out said proposed road No. 775 petitioned for as follows: In the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NW¹NE⁴) of Section 30, Township 4 North, Range 28 East, W. M., said subdivision being in Road District No. 36 of said County, the center line of said proposed road being particularly described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at a point in the center of the present county road which said point is also in the center line of said Section 30 and which said point bears S 81° 32' E a distance of 2459.4 feet from the northwest corner of said section; thence S 49° 38' E a distance of 567.2 feet to the northerly line of the right of way of Oregon Railroad and Navigation Company; thence on the same line produced (S 49° 38' E) a distance of 125.6 feet to a point in the center line of said Oregon-Washington Railroad & Navigation Company's railroad, same being engineer's station D' 396 85; thence S 2° 33' W a distance of 104.5 feet, more or less to a point in the southerly line of the right of way of said Oregon-Washington Railroad & Navigation Company; thence on the same line produced S 2° 33' W a distance of 695.1 feet, more or less to a point in the center of the present county road, said road to be sixty feet in width; and the same having been publicly read on two different days of the same term of Court; and the Board of County Road Viewers having recommended that said road be established and the plat and field notes being on file and there being no objections or remonstrances on file against said road,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the Court that said report of the County Road Viewers be approved, and that the road supervisor through whose district said road runs be, and he is hereby ordered to open said road for public use.

In the Matter of Vacating County Road
Commencing at a point in the center line
of Sec. 30, Tp. 4, N. R. 28, E. W. M.

Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard upon the report of the County Road Viewers heretofore instructed by the Court to view, survey and report upon said road which is proposed to be vacated, petitioned for as follows: In the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 30, Township 4 North, Range 28 East, W. M., the same being in Road District No. 36 of said County, the center line of the road to be vacated being particularly described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at a point in the center line of the present county road which said point is also in the center line of said Section 30 and which said point bears S 81° 32' East a distance of 2459.4 feet from the Northwest corner of Section 30; thence south on the center line of said section a distance of 900 feet; thence southeasterly to a point which is 1619.1 feet south and 2922.5 feet east of the northwest corner of said section, and there terminating, for the vacating of a County Road, the same having been publicly read on two different days of the same term of Court, and the said Board of County Road Viewers having reported favorably and recommended that said road be vacated at such time when County Road No. 775 shall have been established and opened to the general public and that the plat and field notes being on file, and there being no remonstrance or objections on file against said report and the Court being satisfied that said road is not of sufficient public utility,

IT IS THEREFORE HEREBY ORDERED that said report of the Board of County Road Viewers be approved and that said road be vacated and that the plat and field notes be recorded in the record of plats and field notes of Umatilla County and that the Road supervisor through whose district said road is now established be, and he is hereby ordered and instructed to close the same to public travel.
