

REPORT OF
BOARD OF COUNTY ROAD VIEWERS.

In the Matter of Viewing, Surveying
and Laying out County Road No. 775.

To The Honorable County Court of the State of Oregon, for Umatilla County.

We, the undersigned Board of County Road Viewers, heretofore instructed to view, survey and locate Road No. 775, submit the following report:

Pursuant to an order of the Honorable County Court, we met at the County Court House and proceeded to place of survey, on the 13th day of October, 1915.

We called to our aid

W. J. Stockman, Chairman

L. C. Rothrock, Chairman

who were by the Surveyor each duly sworn. We viewed, surveyed, and located said Road No. 775, as specified in our order. We find said route practical and recommend the adoption of the same. The O. W. R. & N. Co. have constructed this road so there will be no construction cost to the County. Before this road is accepted by the County the above Railroad Co. should be required to widen the road fill, under the R. R. bridge, and be required to keep the same in good condition. We find that the N. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$, sec. 30, T. 4 N.; R. 28, E. W. M. is damaged to the extent of \$40.00. We therefore recommend that Road No. 775 be adopted as a County Highway, when the above conditions are fulfilled.

NOTES OF SURVEY OF ROAD NO. 775.

Surveyed Oct. 13, 1915.

TO the Honorable County Court, Umatilla County, Ore.

I submit the following as the notes of the survey of Road No. 775. Began at a point on the North and South center line of Sec. 30 T. 4 N.; R. 28 E. W. M., which is S. 81° 32' E. 2459.4 ft. from the N. W. Cor. of said Sec; ran thence, S. 49°-38' E. a distance of 567.2 ft. to the northerly line of the O. W. R. & N. Co. Right of Way.

692.8 ft. the center line of said O. W. R. & N. Co. R. R. thence, S. 2°-33' W.

104.5 ft. to South line of O. W. R. & N. Right of Way.

799.6 ft. to a point in the center of the present County Road. Marked fence post 20 ft.

South of above point R. 775.
