

To the Honorable County Court
of Umatilla County, State of Oregon.

Your petitioners W. M. Carniceas
and W. D. Lehall citizens and residents
of Umatilla County, Oregon Respectfully
Shows.

1 That your petitioners are the owners
in fee of certain lands in the
County of Umatilla, Oregon
over which a wagon road
known as County Road No.
171 running from the bridge
near the mouth of Butte Creek
to the Town of Foster in said
Umatilla County, Oregon.

2 That the course which said
road runs over your petitioners
land is a great damage
there to

3 That your petitioners pray that
the course of said road be
changed so as to run as follows,
beginning at a point about
Twenty rods West from the
South East corner of the
South West quarter of Section
No Thirty Six in Township
No Four North of Range No
Twenty-Eight East of W. M. in
said County being fifty feet
West of a small bridge over
which said bridge now passes

and running thence in a North
westerly direction about three
quarters of a mile, and thence
west to the intersection of the
said County road about
one mile, as the same is
now laid out and fenced
one said lands of petitioners
That said road will, if changed
as your petitioners request,
run over and on as good ground
as the road does as now laid
out and will not materially
increase the distance to the
injury of the public, but will
be a shorter road and will
be in fact a benefit to the
public.

And your petitioners pray that
viewers may be appointed
to view said road as by law
required and to report to this
Honorable Court and that
upon the coming in of said
report the petition of your
petitioners be granted and
your petitioners will ever pray
dated March 6th A.D. 1889.
