In the Matter of County Road No. 763
petitioned for by Allen H. Moore, et al ROAD NO. 763

Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard upon the report of the board of County Road Viewers heretofore instructed at the March 1914 term of this Court to view, survey, and report upon said proposed road No. 763 and also upon the remonstrance to said petition filed herein and signed by Joseph Vey and others and it duly appearing to the Court that said remonstrance contains the signatures of more legal signers than there is contained on the Petition filed herein.

It is therefore hereby ordered that said report of the Board of County Road Viewers be not approved and said petition is hereby denied.

In the Matter of County Road No. 762
Petitioned for by P. M. Warren, et al ROAD NO. 762.

Now on this Day this matter coming on regularly to be heard upon the report of the board of County Road Viewers heretofore instructed at the March 1914 term of this Court to view, survey, and report upon said proposed road No. 762 petitioned for as commencing at a point on the County Road 60 rods Southeast from the NW corner of the NE 1/4 Sec. 10 TP. 2 N.R. 30 E.M.E. at a post set in the ground marked R thence in a southeasterly direction on the most practical route to a point on the County Road 230 yards Southwest from the center of section 8, Township 1 North Range 31 and to be 60 feet wide as a County Road for final hearing, the same having been publicly read on two different days of the same term of Court to-wit: having been publicly read the first time on April 2nd, 1914 and publicly read the second time on April 6th, 1914 and the said board of County Road Viewers having reported favorably and recommended that said road be established as a public highway of Umatilla County and the plat and field notes being on file, and certified to by the Surveyor who surveyed the same and there being no remonstrance or objections on file against said report or petition filed herein,

It is hereby ordered that said report of the Board of County Road Viewers be approved and that said road be declared a public highway of Umatilla County and that the plat and field notes be recorded in the records of plat and field notes of Umatilla County and the Road Supervisor through whose district said road runs be and is hereby ordered and instructed to open said road for public use.

Whereupon the hour of adjournment having arrived the Court adjourned for the Term.
