

In the Matter of opening
County Road No. 746

Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard upon the report of the Board of County Road Viewers heretofore instructed at the April 1913 term of this Court to view, survey and report upon said proposed County Road petitioned for as Commencing at a point 20 feet west of the O.W.R. & N right of way and 60 rods east of the center of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 22 Tp. 1 N. R. 32 E.W.M. thence northerly parallel with and 20 feet from said right of way through sections 22-15- 10- 9 and 4 to a point 20 rods east of the center of sections 4 Tp 1 N. R. 32 E.W.M. and to be 40 feet wide as a County Road. or final hearing the same having been publicly read on 2 different days of the same term of Court to-wit: having been publicly read the first time on May 7th, 1913 and publicly read the second time on May 8th 1913 and the plat and field notes being on file and certified to by the surveyor appointed by survey the same and there being no remonstrance on file against said petition or report of viewers and the Board of county Road viewers having reported favorably and recommended that said road be established as a public highway of Umatilla County and the court being satisfied that said road is of public utility that the damages should be paid by Umatilla County.

It is therefore hereby ordered that said report of the board of County Road viewers be approved and that the same be recorded in the record of plats and field notes of Umatilla County and that the road Supervisor through whose district said road runs is hereby ordered to open said road for public use. At such time when the petitioners shall have been paid the damages sustained to the property owners as follows: J. Guderain \$260.00.

Now on this day there is presented to the Court the petition of Joseph Cunha and 14 other freeholders who are residents of the road district or road districts wherein said proposed road is to be paid out. Praying this court to lay out and establish a county road commencing in the County Road at the NE corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 14 Tp 3 N. R. 29 E.W.M. and terminating at the County road at the east end of the County Bridge crossing the Government canal in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 9 Tp 3 N. R. 29 E.W.N. and the District Attorney having disapproved said petition for the reason that the terminating point is indefinitely described.

It is therefore hereby ordered by the court that said petition be and the same is hereby denied.

County Road No. 747
Reservation Road No. 1

Now on this day there is presented to the Court the petition of Charles Hamilton and 23 other freeholders who are residents of the Road District or road districts wherein said proposed road to be known as County Road No. 747 (Reservation Road No. 1) is to be paved out and established praying this court to cause to be laid out and established a County Road commencing at a point 26 rods North of the SW corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 7 Tp 2 N. R. 33 E.W.M. thence easterly on the present traveled road to the NE corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 8 Tp 2 N. R. 33 E.W.M. thence east to a point 40 rods west of the NW corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 12 Tp 2 N. R. 33 thence following the present traveled road southerly to the SW corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 25 of said township and range; thence southeasterly on the most practical route to a point 16 rods east of the NE corner of Sec. 17 Tp 1 N. R. 35 E.W.M.

And it duly appearing to the court that due notice of the presentation of said petition has been given by the posting of three notices in the vicinity of said proposed road as by law required.

Rothrock as viewers meet in Pendleton Oregon on the 20th day of May, 1913 or if unable to meet on that day then within five days thereafter and proceed to view, stake and lay out said proposed road and make due return of their doings to the court at its next regular term.

Reservation Road NO. 2

Now on this day there is presented to the Court petition of Charles Hamilton and 24 other freeholders who are residents of the road district or road districts wherein said proposed County road to be known as County Road No. 748 (Reservation Road No. 2) praying this court to cause to be laid out and established a County Road commencing at the NW corner of Sec. 13 Tp 2 N. R. 33 E.W.M. thence east to the NE corner of Sec. 16 Tp 2 N. R. 34 E.W.M. and there terminating.

And it duly appearing to the court that due notice of the presentation of said petition has been given by the posting of three notices in the vicinity of said proposed road as by law required.
