

ROAD NOTICE.

TO ALL PERSONS WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Notice is hereby given that a petition will be presented to the County Court of the state of Oregon, for Umatilla County, by the undersigned, who are residents and householders of said county and state, and reside in the vicinity of the hereinafter described route for a county road, at the May term, 1903, of said county court, to-wit, on the 6th day of May, 1903, praying said court to lay out, locate, and establish a county road in said county and state, commencing, running, and terminating, as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at a point on the county road leading from the City of Pendleton, Umatilla County, Oregon, to Pilot Rock, Umatilla County, Oregon, at or near the southeast corner of the southwest quarter of Section Twenty-seven, Township one, North of Range Thirty-two, East of the Willamette Meridian, in said county and state, said point being upon the section line between Sections 27 and 28 of said township and range; thence running westerly one and one-half miles along said section line to the southwest corner of the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter of Section 28, in said township and range; thence running northerly one mile along the legal subdivision line separating the east half and the west half of the west half of said section 28, to the section line between Sections 21 and 23, in said township and range; thence running westerly along said section line and extension thereof three-fourths of a mile to a point on the county road leading from the Lee Crossing, so-called, in said county and state, to said Pilot Rock, at or near the southeast corner of the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter of Section 20, in said township and range, said proposed road terminating at said latter point.

Said road to be forty feet wide.
