Commencing at the center Sec 29, T 4 N R 34 E N M. Set post 30' West of point, Marked R. 497, dug pits and raised mound around post.

Thence North 3990 chains A 1

Next 1750 5740. Set post 30' West Marked R. 497, dug pits and raised mound around post.
