WE THE UNDERSIGNED, your petitioners, who are freeholders of said Umatilla County, Oregon, and who reside in the road district, or districts where said road is to be laid out, respectfully petition your honorable body to cause to be laid out, located, and established a County road in said County and State, commencing, running and terminating as follows, to-wit: Commencing at a point in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 17 Tp

1 S R 32 E W M, N 38 degs E 200 feet distant from angle No.

2 of county road No. 617 thence in a northwesterly and a south westerly direction on the most practicable rout to the N W corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 17, thence west along section lines as near as practicable between Sec 8 & 17, 7 & 18 Tp 1 S R 32 E W M and Sec 12 & 13, 11 & 14, 10 & 15, 9 & 16, 8 & 17 Tp 1 S R 31 E W M to intersect county road No. 646 at N W corner of Sec 17 Tp 1 S R 31 E W M

Said road to be 60 feet wide
