WHEREUPON, a term of said Court is begun and holden on Tue the 11th day of June 1907, the same being the 6th Judicial day of said term, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard upon the report of the Board of County Road Viewers, heretofore instructed at the May 1907 term of this Court, to view, survey and report upon said proposed road No. 633, commencing at the South East corner of the North East quarter of Section 13, Tp 1 South Range 30-1/2 E. W. M., run thence north 73 degrees east 488 ft; thence North 59 deg East 847 ft; thence North 45 deg East 1129 feet; thence North 41 degrees East 255 ft. thence North 34 deg East 1954 feet; thence East 3071 feet; thence East 315 feet; thence North 66deg & 30' East 1357 feet; thence North 50 deg east 1738 feet; thence North 44 degrees East 1425 ft; thence North 31 deg 15' East 435 feet; thence North 21 degrees 15' East 2447 ft; thence North 2546 feet; thence East 287 feet; thence East 315 feet; thence North 19deg 30' East 2800 ft. thence in a north easterly direction down the gulch there and on a line as nearly as practicable 30 ft North from the bottom line of said gulch through the Northeast quarter of Section 33, the North West quarter of Section 34, the South half of Section 27, the North East quarter of Section 27, all in township 1 North, Range 31 EWM. to a point in the West half of the north West Quarter of Section 26, in said Tp and Range last mentioned,

which point is 30 ft North of a post 4 ft long and 4 inches square set 18 inches in the ground, marked 7 M.; thence North 51 degrees East 475 feet; thence North 58 degrees 5 minuted East 325 ft: thence North 88 deg East 1183 ft; thence North 41 deg 45' East 1795 ft; thence North 87 deg 20' East 1395 ft; thence East along the section lines between sections 24 and 25 in Township 1 North, Range 31 EWM and between sections 19 and 30, in Tp 1 North, Range 32 EWM. to the North East corner of said section 30 in Tp 1 North, Range 32 EWM. there to intersect a county road known as the Pilot Rock Road, as a county road for final hearing, the same having been publicly read on the two different days of the same term of court, to-wit: Having been publicly read the 1st time on June 5th 1907 and publicly read the 2nd time on June 6th 1907, and the plat and field notes being on file, and certified to by the surveyor appointed to survey the same, and the said board of county road viewers having reported favorably, and recommended the opening of said road as to the last one mile and 48.42 chains, to-wit: Commencing at the South West corner of the South East quarter of section 24, tp 1 North Range 31 EWM; thence East between South East quarter Section 24, and the North East quarter of Section 25, and between sections 19 and 30 in Tp 1 North Range 32 EWM; to the corner common to Section 19, 20, 29 and 30, tp 1 North Range 32 EWM. And the court having viewed the location of said road finds that the 1st or all of said road ^{part} except the last two miles 48.42 chains is covered by road No. 632 and therefore would not be of sufficient public utility. And the court being satisfied that the last one mile and 48.42 chains as hereinbefore described would be of sufficient public utility, it is therefore hereby ordered that the said report be accepted, and the plat and field notes be recorded in the record of Plats and Field Notes of Umatilla County, and that the road supervisor through whose district said road runs be and he is hereby ordered and instructed to open said road in accordance with said report and with this order.
