Road No. 554

To the Honorable County Court of Umatilla County, State of Oregon.

We the undersigned board of road viewers beg to submit the following report on road No 554. Commencing at the N.W. corner of Sec 33. Township 3 North Range 30 E. W. M. We met on Nov 21th. 1903. at the time and place appointed to survey said road. but were not able to do any work on account of a heavy rain. We therefore adjourned to meet again Nov 24th on this later date we met and after calling to our aid W^m F. Yoshika. as Chairman and duly qualifying we proceeded. and viewed and surveyed the said road. also the road to be vacated according to the requirements of law as indicated by the accompanying field notes. plat profile and so forth. and found the location for the proposed new road in our opinion to be a good and desirable location for a County road. in place of the Old road to be vacated that the present ground surface will make a good road grade. without extra grading and that none of the adjoining premises are rendered less valuable by the proposed change.

We therefore recommend that the said proposed road No 554 be established and that the above mentioned old road commencing at a point about 30 rods North of S.W. cor. of Sec 33. in said Township and Range. be vacated Respectfully submitted
