

To the Honorable County Court of the State of Oregon, for  
Umatilla County:

WE, THE UNDERSIGNED, your petitioners, who are residents and householders in Umatilla County, Oregon, and who reside in the vicinity of the hereinafter described route for a County road, respectfully petition your honorable body to cause to be laid out, located and established, a County road in said County and State, commencing, running and terminating as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at a pile of rocks Two Hundred and Fifty yards northwest of the North East corner of the Southeast quarter of the northeast quarter of Section Thirty-three, Township Four South Range Thirty-one East W.M. and running in a Southeasterly direction along the present traveled road to the northeast corner of the northwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section Thirty four; thence on the quarter section line due South to where it intersects the County Road at R. E. Sturdivant's gate

Said road to be Sixty (60) feet wide.

And your petitioners will ever pray.
