

Notes of Survey of Road No. 774.

Surveyed June 1<sup>st</sup> 1915

To the Honorable County Court

Umatilla County Oregon

I submit.

The following as the notes of the Survey of Road No. 774.

Began at the N.W. cor. of Sec. 1, T. 6 S.; R. 31 E. N. M. which is a large stone, marked c.c., with a stone mound around it. Marked a fence post at above stone R. 774. Ran thence East 350.0 feet to center of a road.

" 370.0 " " a point 25 ft. South of a fence cor. a fence runs north and one East.

" 2387.0 " the  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor., a stone and stone mound, on South boundary of Sec. 35, T. 5 S.; R. 31 E. N. M.

" 5045.0 " cor. of Sections 35 & 36 on the First Standard Parallel South.

5280.0 " Marked telephone post, 40 ft. north, M. 1.

5319.0 " North East cor. of Sec. 1, T. 6 S.; R. 31 E. N. M. a large stone and stone mound.
