



**NARRATIVE:**

The purpose of this survey was to establish the boundaries of a new parcel purchased by John Picard. The control used for this survey is the same as originally used in a survey for Gale Marshall, County Survey Drwg. No. G-1119-A, with the exception of the PK nail shown at the intersection of S.E. 9th and Isaac. This point was a R/R spike in the previous survey, it was destroyed during construction work on S.E. 9th. The PK nail has recently been reset by the City of Pendleton and they intend to place a Brass Cap at this point within the next month. Bearings are based upon the Original Plat of Reservation Addition to the City of Pendleton.
