



NARRATIVE:

The purpose of this survey was to set the boundaries of that parcel of land as described in the Umatilla County Deed Records on Roll 114, Page 2082.

Control for this survey was a found railroad spike on the East-West centerline of Section 6, T4N, R29E, and a bolt spike at the W 1/4 C-C of Sec. 6 as shown on a survey by Wayne Harris Co, in 1974 for Leo Ritter, Link, Tompkins, Co Surveyor No. 1-196-A. Bearings were based on the same drawing.
