
NARRATIVE

This survey was performed at the request of the Columbia Development Authority to locate and monument the boundary of the 1944 UMCD Igloo Accident site as directed in Ammendment #1 to the Programmatic Agreement among the Department of the Army, Oregon State Historic Preservation Office, Advisory Council on Historic Preservation, Columbia Development Authority, and Confederated Tribes of the Umatilla Indian Reservation.

Record monuments from Umatilla County Map of Survey 16—018—C are found and verified.

The North line of the 1944 UMCD Igloo Site is then located 20 feet south of the centerline of Block B, Road A. The boundary is monumented as shown.

This survey was performed utilizing Trimble R6/R8 GPS receivers and Topcon Survey Pro data collection.
