WEST PORTION OF SECTION 18 T.1 S.R.33 E.W.M.

OBJECT: To locate the South line of lots 6,7,8,15,16, The West line of lot 16 and the East line of lot 15, all in Section 18,T,1S.R.33 E.W.M.

MONUMENTS FOUND:

THE west 1/4 Cor Section 19,T.1 S.R.33, a stone about 8"x10"x18" standing on end, about 10" in the ground, Marked "1/4 C.C." on the East face. a small mound of stones around it.

The S.W. Corner Section 18 T.1 S.R.33 E.W.M, a rock jack with old established fences running North and South and East.

THE S.E. Corner of Section 13 T.1 S.R.32 E.W.M. a rock jack with old established fences running N & S. and West.

The East 1/4 Corner Section 13 T.1 S. R.32 E.W.M. Found a charred post, (bottom part only in the ground) and a mound of stones around it, from which a fence corner bears North 3 ft. and East 2 ft.

The west 1/4 Corner of Section 18,T.1 S.R.33 E.W.M was questioned by a Rancher in the Area. Having found sufficient evidence of corners on the West line of Section 18, I proceeded with the Survey.

FROM THE EAST 1/4 Corner of Section 13 T.1 S.R.32 E.W.M I run S.0°25'W.along the West line of Section 18.

409.5 ft.

Set 1/2" I.P. on N-S fence line, Raised a mound of stones around it, for the WEST 1/4 Corner of Sec.18,T.1 S.R.33; From which a fence corner bears South 5 ft.

997.90 ft.

From the West 1/4 Corner Section 18 I run thence Due East, Set 1/2"x24" I.P. for S.E. Corner of lot 6. Raised a mound of stones around it, from which an E-W fence bears South 4 ft.

Thence Continuing Due East

3637.92 ft.

Set 1/2"x24" I.P. for the S.E. Corner of lot 3. Raised a mound of stones around it, from which a four way fence corner bears

South 9 ft. and East 41 ft.

FROM THE WEST 1/4 Corner Section 18 T.1 S.R.33 EVM I run S.0°25'W.
along the West line of said Section 18.

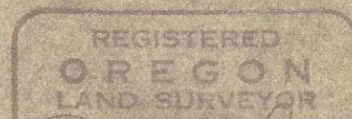
1314.7 ft. Temporary Corner for the S.W. Corner of lot 17, from which I run
Due East.

1001.9 Set 1"x40" I.P. in wheat field with a 6 ft piece of channel Iron
along side of it, from which a 36" walnut tree and fence corner
bears North 25 ft. and East 3 ft. Thence Continuing Due East.

3641.88 Set 5/8"x30" I.P. and raised a mound of stones arround it, from
which a N-S fence bears East 2.5 ft.

Land was steep and rocky, line was run with a K&E Transit, with
a one minute vernier reading having a 6 1/2" Horizontal circle.
Distance was measured with a 300 ft. steel tape. Temperature
averaged 60°, a slight breeze occasionally but no strong wind.
