



**NARRATIVE:**

The purpose of this survey was to locate the boundary of that parcel belonging to Bob O'Rourke, being the South 44.00 feet of Lot 1 and the North 28.00 feet of Lot 2, Block 2 of Stanger Hills Addition to the City of Pendleton, Oregon.

The 3/8" pin found at the end of N.W. 5th on centerline is of unknown origin as is the 3/8" pin found, however they are in the correct location, the other 3/8" pins found are from a survey by Krumbein Eng. for Paul Richards dated 9-17-80, Umatilla County Surveyor No. P-164-Ax.

Bearings were based on the original plat of Stanger Hills Addition.
