


NARRATIVE

The purpose of this survey was to establish the boundaries of a 78.97 acre parcel, being sold to Wayne Richards. The North and East sides of the parcel were established by this firm, Umatilla County Surveyors Drwg No. A-143-B. The Northeast quarter was also broken into two pieces in the North-South direction during this survey, but not monumented. This survey was to set the North-South centerline of the Northeast quarter and the South line of State Highway 204. Bearings are based upon Umatilla County Surveyors Drwg. No. L-56-B by James Hanley.
