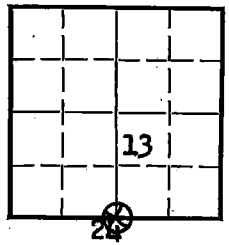

 Set stone 12 x 10 x 10 for 1/4 section corner.  
 Fir 30 inches diameter bears S 5° E 3/4 links distant  
 Alder 4 inches diameter bears N 44° E 2/4 links distant.

5. Investigation Notes: Found blazed 28" Alder with scribing on east face. The scribing looked like: *K 2 3 W*. No stone within required distance. No evidence of 30" fir B.T. or the stump. 28" Alder B.T. is approximately 1 chain from Umatilla River and still alive. Placed B.T. sign on east face of the 28" Alder. Placed do-not destroy sign on west side of the same tree. Placed K. Tag on 16" P.P. at the out-let of the fish pond on south side of road at the Canyon Ranch. Put 3 strips of orange ribbon and 2 strips of silver paint on 28" Alder B.T. Take a S 79° E bearing from Bobsled Creek sign board, Cross Umatilla River, keeping between the river and N.W. slope in creek bottom. Follow blazed trees with silver paint. This will lead to the Alder B.T.
