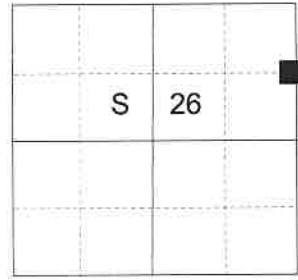


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO MONUMENT THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At position determined by survey, I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin, 28" in the ground, with a 2 1/2" aluminum cap, marked as shown below, from which:

NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

A 3" diam. Douglas Fir bears North 77° East, a distance of 10.35 feet, marked X BT.

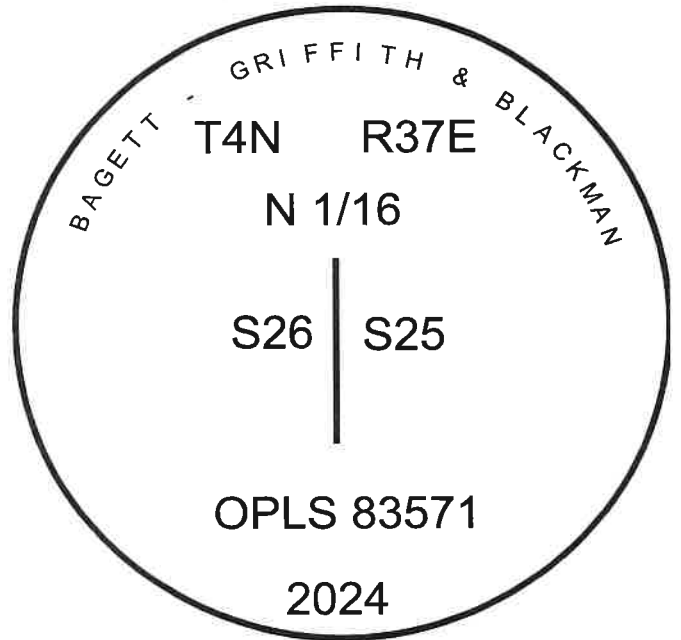
A 5" Douglas Fir bears North 32° West, a distance of 47.95 feet, marked N 1/16 S26 BT.

Set steel fencepost 0.5 feet West.

Falls on East aspect of North/South running ridge line.
