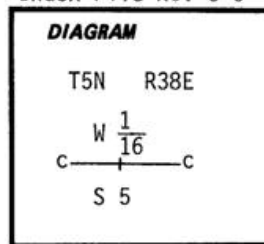


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At surveyed point set 1"x30" Galvanized Pipe with 3" brass cap stamped:

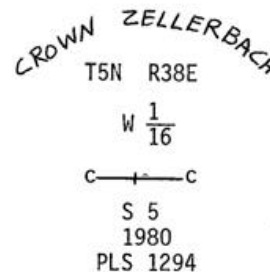
Set pipe 26" in ground with rock and dirt to cap.

New BTs:

A Spruce 12" dia. bears S2⁰E, 23.5 ft., scribed CW 1/16 S5 BT.

A White Fir 10" dia. bears N58⁰E, 13.1 ft., scribed CW 1/16 S5 BT.

Attached 54-3 and 54-9 signs to both BTs. Attached brass washer stamped LS 1294 to foot blaze of both BTs. Painted blazes and 6" band around both BTs red.
