A Lodgepole 6" dia., $N84\frac{10}{2}$ W, 5.7 ft, with scribing visible. A Lodgepole stump, 6" dia., S52 E, 10.6 ft. with scribing visible.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Marked a new BT: A Lodgepole, 6" dia., N6120E, 46.0 ft. marked: N1/16 S2 BT

BTs have blaze and a 6" stripe painted red, a BT tag and a "Land Survey Monument" sign. The new BT has, additionally, an alum. "PLS 1832" washer nailed to the bottom of the blaze. There is a 6' steel fence post with a "Land Survey Monument" sign within 5' of the corner.

Measured to center of BTs using steel tape and staff compass. Magnetic declination set at $18^{\rm O}{\rm E}$.
