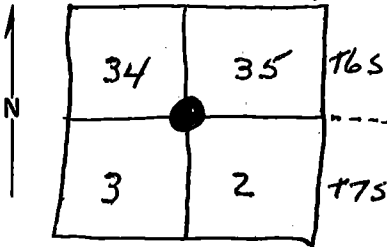

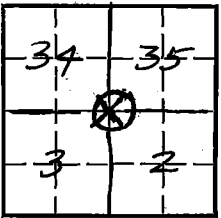

4. Description of Corners: Originally a fir post which is now gone. Of the four BT's only two remain. One is a mistletoed Douglas-fir and the other a 4" Larch snag with the scribbing opened up.

5. Investigation Notes: I walked down the trail on the east side of Trough Cr. past the first saddle and almost to the second saddle near Spine Cob Knob. I found a pine blazed with an 'X' on the east edge of the trail. Near there was a small tree blazed ~~with~~ and with writing which told to go 5 1/2 chains east to the corner. I followed plastic flagging to the corner. The fir 27 lks from the corner is standing and alive with a 1937 cruiser's tag on it the 4" Larch is standing but dead. The scribbing was chopped out. I put a BT shield sign on it and painted an aluminum BT in both trees.
