General Description

For about 15 miles the Blue Mountains have been about ten miles South of the base line ~~and~~ their sides are covered with Pine & Fir Timber. Numerous small streams flow from their base and empty into McKay's Creek Willow & Butter Creek. The land is very rich and level or gently rolling to the foot of the mountains and covered with a thick growth of excellent "bunch grass".

The Musatilla River on the north of the line about twelve miles distant runs parallel with the line west for about 20 miles is a beautiful stream of clear cold water about six rods wide with thick growth of cotton wood timber on its banks and a dense undergrowth of Willow - Rose Bushes & Birch.

There are about forty settlers on this stream.

The Base Line passes about 3 miles South
 of Ft Dalles 5 miles South of Bridge
 over Deschutes River 4 miles South
 of Emigrant Road crossing of John
 Day River 8 miles South of Emigrant
 Road crossing of Willow & Butter
 creeks about twelve miles South
 of Indian Agency on Wawatla
 River

Its Terminus is 189 miles East of
 the Willamette River 149 miles East
 of the Summit of the Cascade
 Mountains and 114 miles East
 of Ft Dalles
