From the corner to Township 283 North of Range 27 &amp; 28 East I run a random line between said Townships East setting temporary half mile and mile posts at 40.00 &amp; 80.00 chains I find the line to be 5 miles 78 chains &amp; 36 links and the falling to be 420 links North of Township
