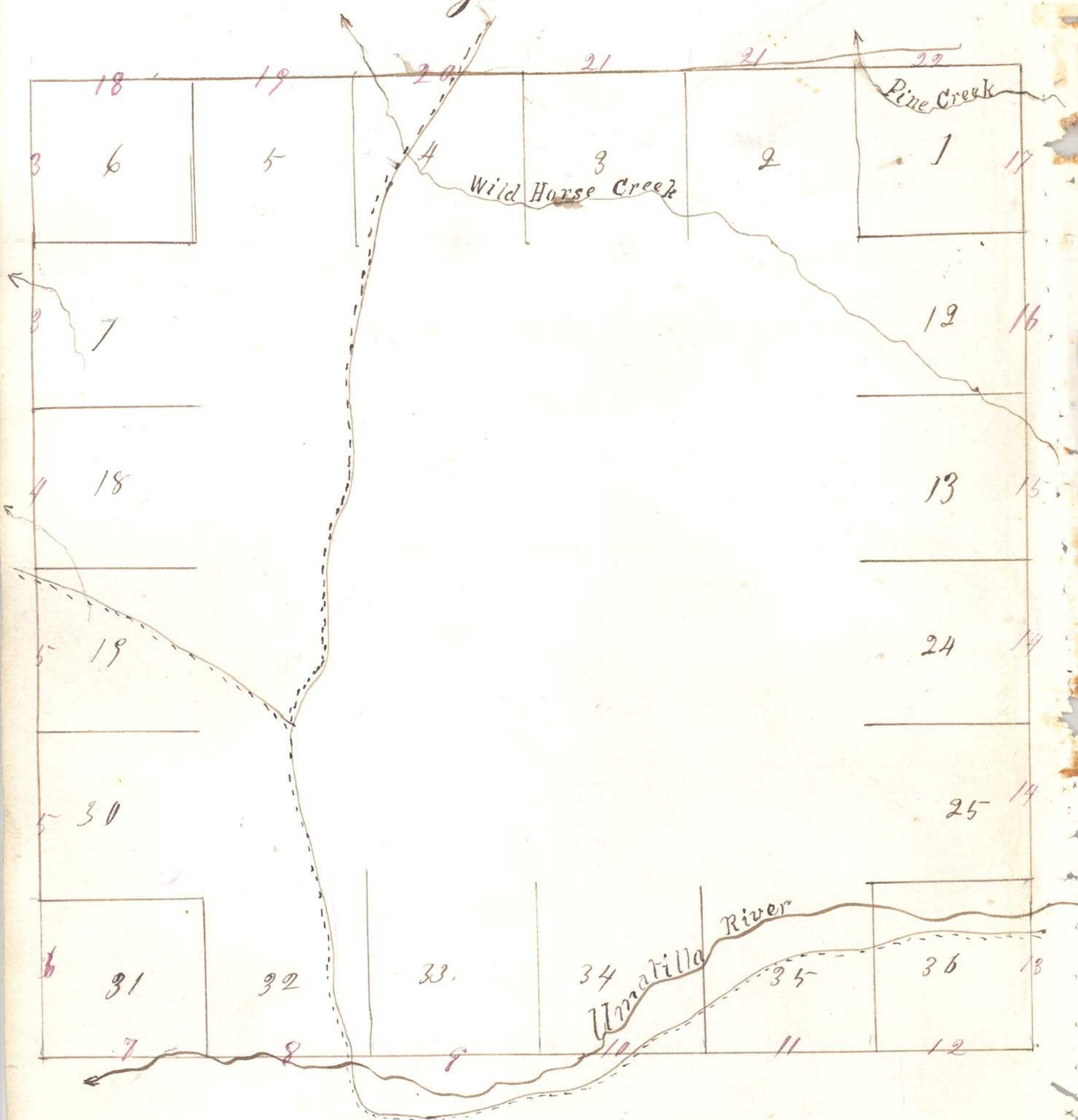

1866.

Commenced July 26<sup>th</sup>  
and completed  
July 31<sup>st</sup> 1866.
