General Description

The surface of this Township is level
or gently rolling; The Soil 2nd rate
and sandy. Good bunch-grass grows
moderately in the Eastern part and
abundantly in the Western part of
the Township. Being convenient
to the Columbia River on the North
and to the Umatilla River on the East
the Township is adapted to cattle
raising. There is no timber in the
Township.
