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Diagram of T. No 5 South R. 31 East

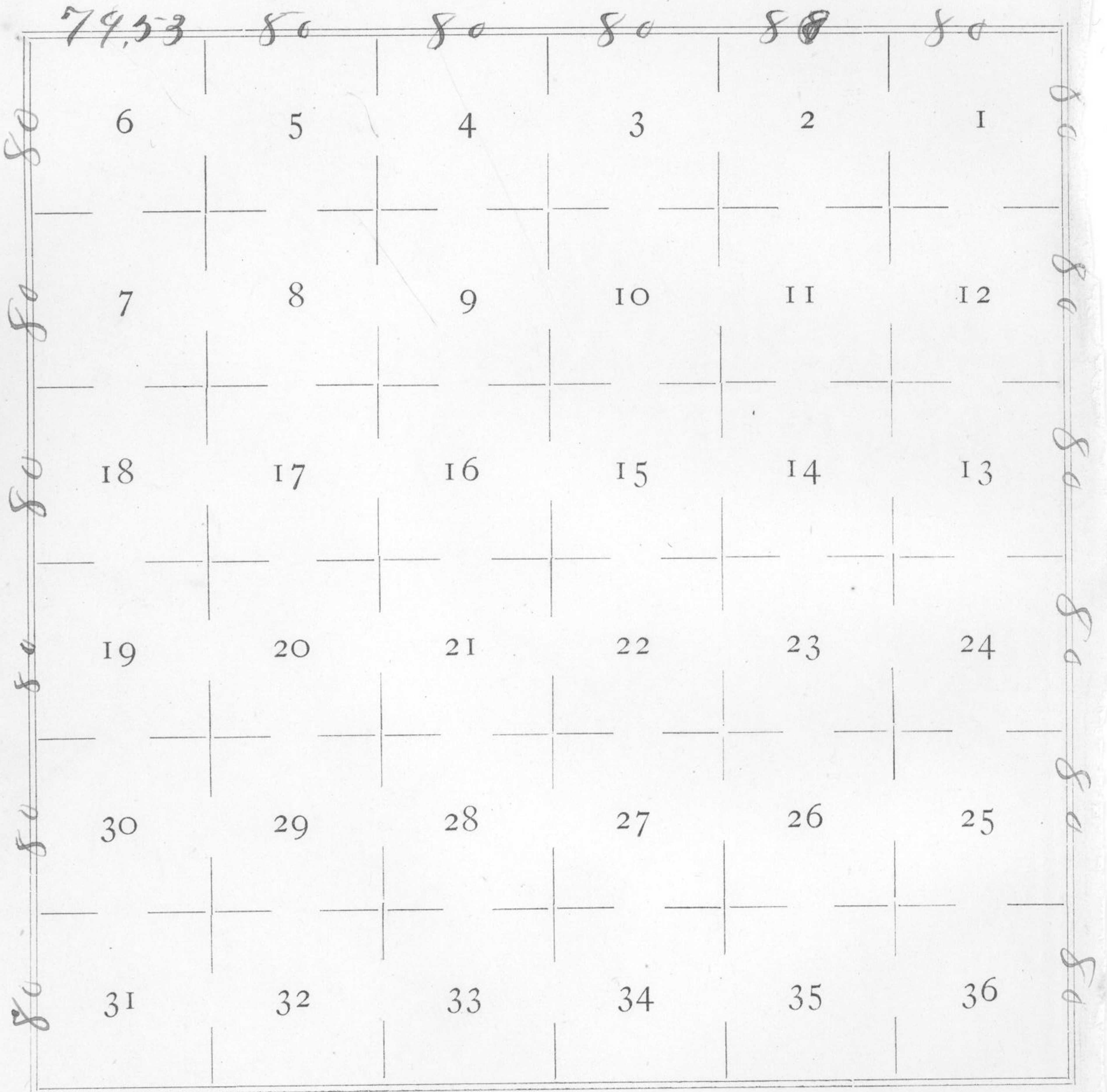
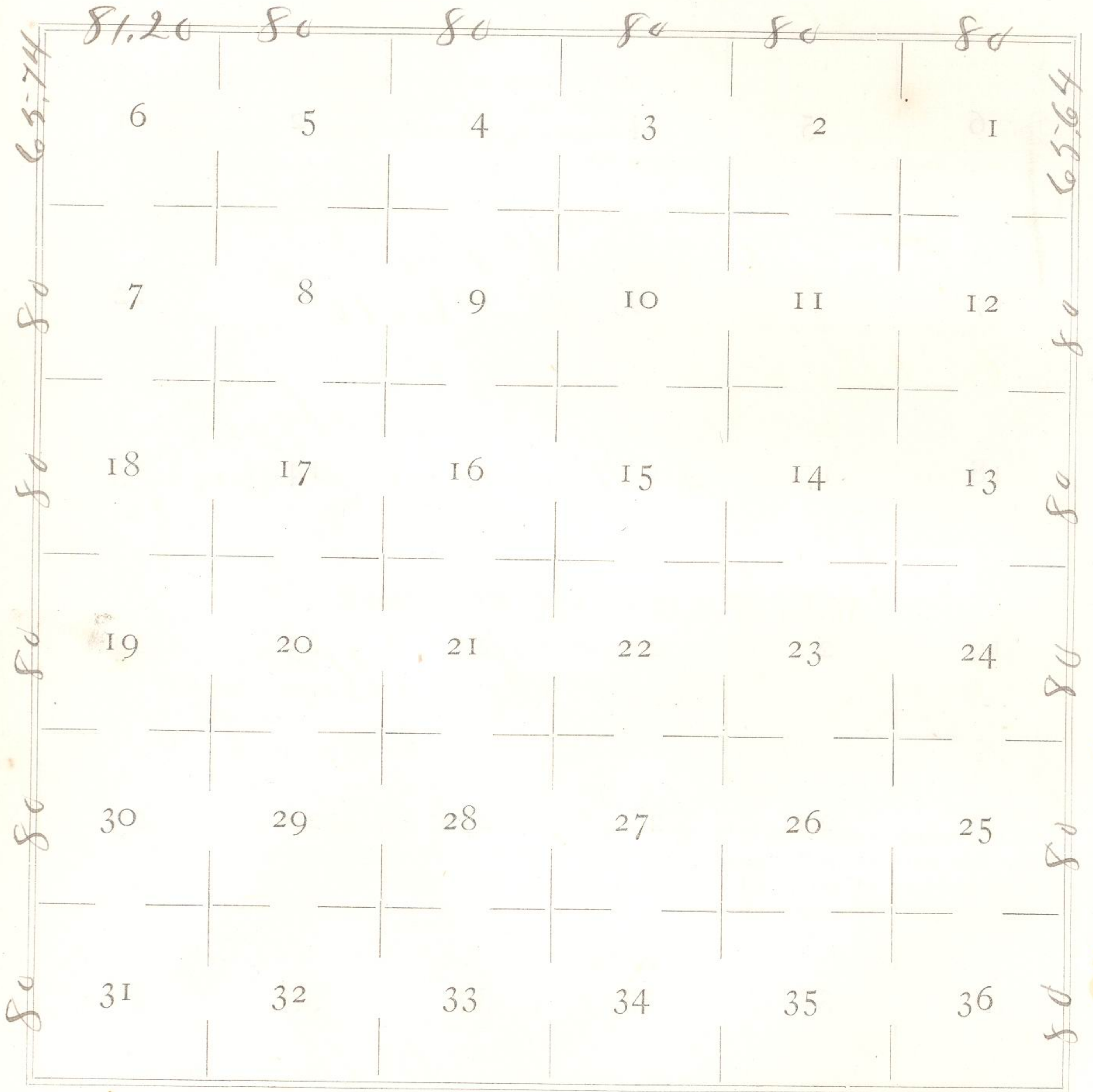


Diagram of T. R.
