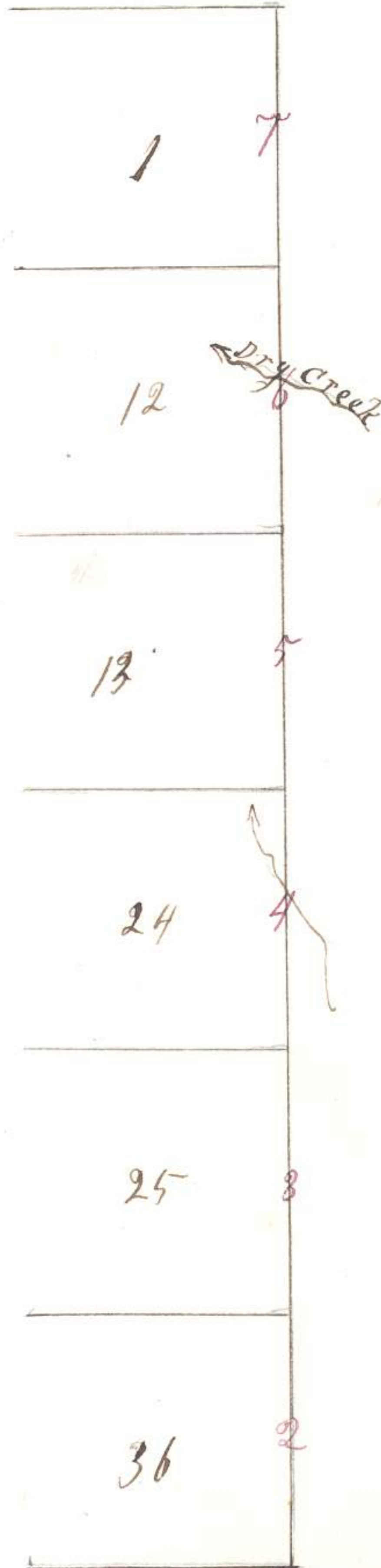

The up lands are thickly covered with buck grass. Valuable Clinias have been located along the streams and in many places on the up lands. Therefore the Township should be subdivided.
