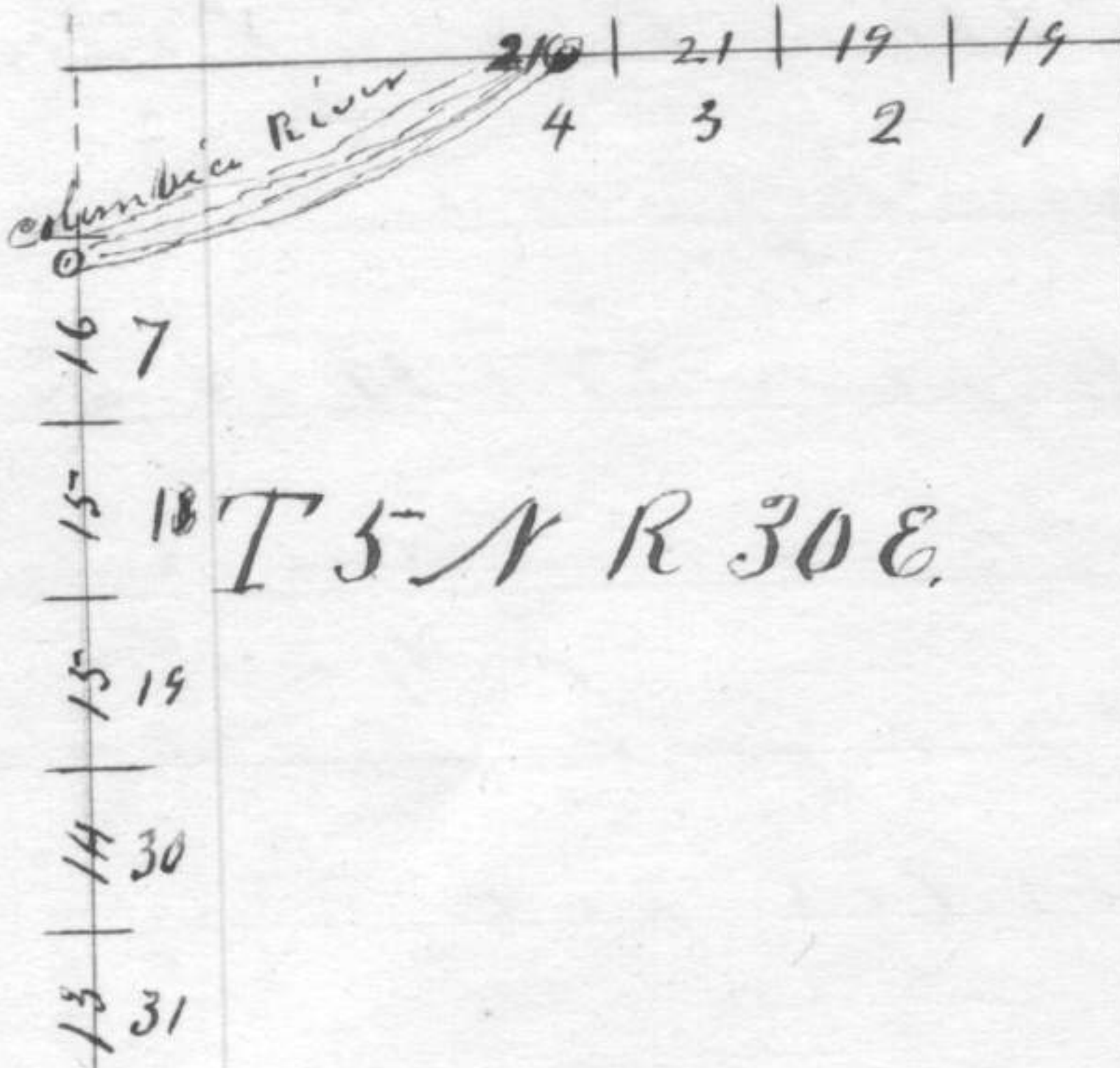
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Exterior boundaries, T3NR30E and T5NR30E



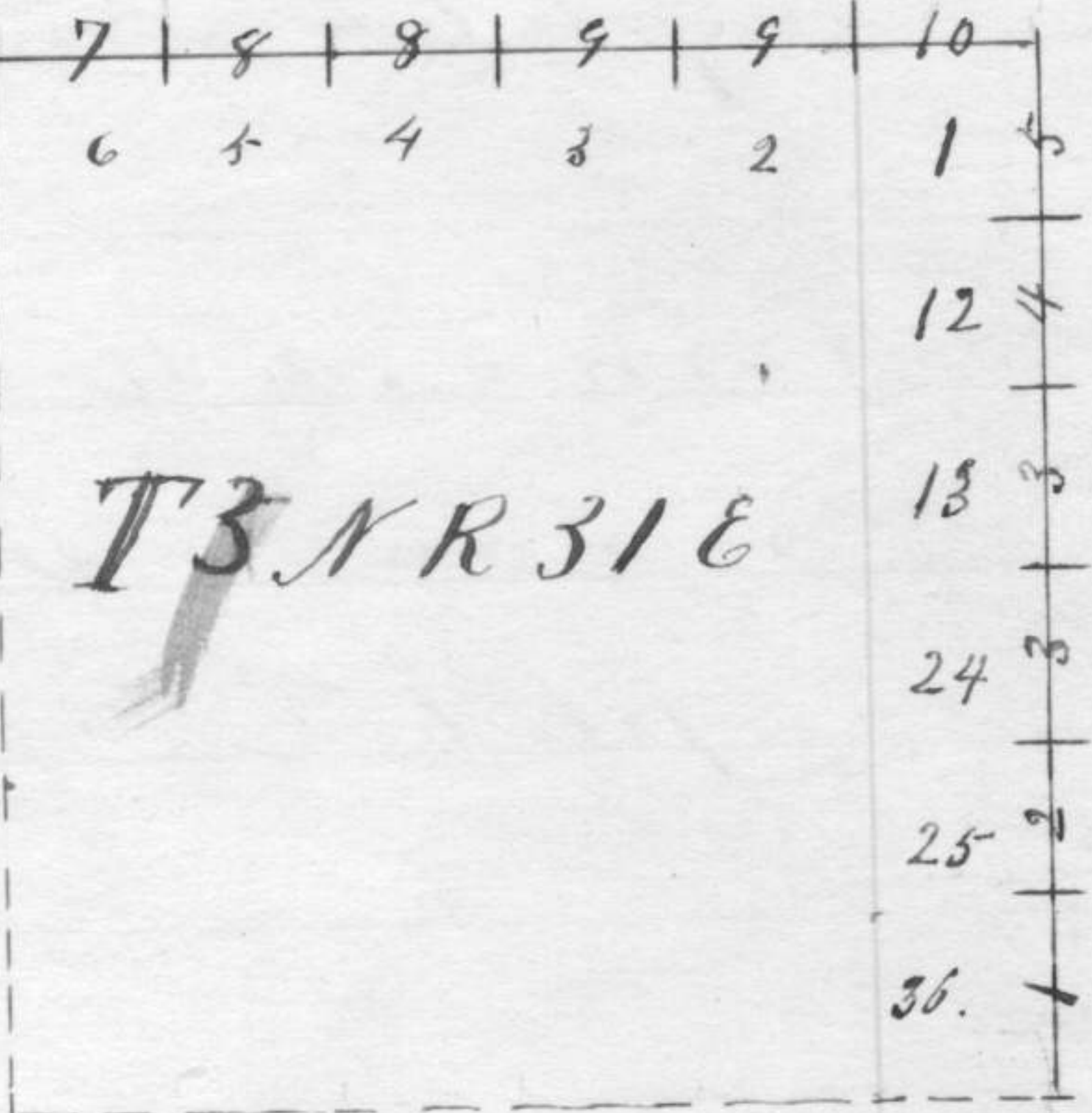
